Co-Insurance For Exhibitors Who Permit Swinging of Clubs:

Any exhibitor who will swing a golf club or permit a customer to do so, MUST have a Certificate of Insurance on file with the Chicago Golf Show®, listing the Chicago Golf Show® and Corcoran Expositions, Inc. as co-insureds. Certificates must be on file in the Chicago Golf Show® office at least 15 days prior (February 10, 2010) to show opening. Failure to have a contract on file shall be grounds for Show Management to deny admission to the Show to said exhibitor.

Insurance:

While all possible care will be exercised by Rosemont Exposition Services and its agents, you are responsible for insuring the safety of your personnel and exhibit materials from theft, damage, accident, fire, and other such causes. Exhibitors who desire to carry insurance must do so at their own expense. All property of the exhibitors is understood to remain in their own care, custody, and control in transit to and from the confines of the exhibit hall as well as when it is on the floor.
